15	(1) manufacture distilled spirits;
16	(2) rectify, purify, and refine distilled spirits and

13	distillery outside of the state may enter into an agreement with the

16	distiller's and rectifier's permitted premises:
17	(1) manufacture distilled spirits;
18	(2) rectify, purify, and refine distilled spirits and
