- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 531.476, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 531.476. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The council:
- 8 (1) shall develop and monitor the implementation of a
- 9 five-year statewide behavioral health strategic plan;
- 10 (2) shall develop a biennial coordinated statewide
- 11 behavioral health expenditure proposal;
- 12 (3) shall annually publish an updated inventory of
- 13 behavioral health programs and services that are funded by the
- 14 state that includes a description of how those programs and
- 15 services further the purpose of the statewide behavioral health
- 16 strategic plan;
- 17 (4) may create subcommittees to carry out the
- 18 council's duties under this subchapter; and
- 19 (5) may facilitate opportunities to increase
- 20 collaboration for the effective expenditure of available federal
- 21 and state funds for behavioral and mental health services in this
- 22 state.
- 23 (b) The council shall include statewide suicide prevention
- 24 efforts in its five-year statewide behavioral health strategic plan

- 1 <u>under Subsection (a).</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter M-1, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 3 amended by adding Section 531.477 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 531.477. SUICIDE PREVENTION SUBCOMMITTEE; SUICIDE
- 5 DATA REPORTS. (a) The council shall create a suicide prevention
- 6 subcommittee to focus on statewide suicide prevention efforts using
- 7 information collected by the council from available sources of
- 8 suicide data reports. The suicide prevention subcommittee shall
- 9 establish guidelines for the frequent use of those reports in
- 10 carrying out the council's purpose under this subchapter.
- 11 (b) The subcommittee created under this section shall
- 12 establish a method for identifying how suicide data reports are
- 13 used to make policy.
- 14 (c) Public or private entities that collect information
- 15 regarding suicide and suicide prevention may provide suicide data
- 16 reports to commission staff designated by the executive
- 17 commissioner to receive those reports.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
