## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to funding for the provision of meals to public school
3	students with insufficient balances on prepaid meal cards or meal
4	accounts.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 33.908, Education Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:

- 8 Sec. 33.908. <u>FUNDING</u> [GRACE PERIOD POLICY] FOR EXHAUSTED OR
- 9 INSUFFICIENT MEAL CARD OR ACCOUNT BALANCE. (a) Each [The board of
- 10 trustees of a school district that allows students to use a prepaid
- 11 meal card or account to purchase meals served at <u>a campus</u> [schools]
- 12 in the district [shall adopt a grace period policy regarding the use
- 13 of the cards or accounts. The policy]:
- 14 (1) must allow a student whose meal card or account
- 15 balance is exhausted or insufficient to continue, for the entire
- 16 school year [a period determined by the board], to purchase meals
- 17 by:
- 18 (A) accumulating a negative balance on the
- 19 student's card or account; or
- 20 (B) otherwise receiving an extension of credit
- 21 from the district; and
- 22 (2) [must require the district to notify the parent of
- 23 or person standing in parental relation to the student that the
- 24 student's meal card or account balance is exhausted;

- 1 [(3)] may not [permit the district to] charge a fee or
- 2 interest in connection with meals purchased under Subdivision (1) [+
- 3 and
- 4 [(4) may permit the district to set a schedule for
- 5 repayment on the account balance as part of the notice to the parent
- 6 or person standing in parental relation to the student].
- 7 (b) At the end of each school year, from funds available for
- 8 the purpose, the agency shall provide a grant to each district in
- 9 the amount necessary to pay the negative balance for each student
- 10 whose meal card or account balance is exhausted or insufficient,
- 11 <u>excluding:</u>
- 12 (1) any amount the school district received from
- 13 private donations from individuals and entities for the purpose of
- 14 paying the negative balance on a student's meal card or account; and
- 15 (2) any amount of reimbursement to which the district
- 16 <u>is entitled under federal law.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
