- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsection (q) to read as follows:
- 8 (q) As part of the minimum curriculum requirements, the
- 9 commission shall require an officer to complete a four-hour
- 10 statewide education and training program developed by the
- 11 commission on techniques to facilitate interaction with persons
- 12 with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias, including techniques
- 13 for recognizing symptoms, communicating effectively, employing
- 14 alternatives to physical restraints, and identifying signs of
- 15 abuse, neglect, or exploitation.
- SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Texas
- 17 Commission on Law Enforcement shall establish the education and
- 18 training program required by Section 1701.253(q), Occupations
- 19 Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. Section 1701.253(q), Occupations Code, as added
- 21 by this Act, applies only to a person who submits an application for
- 22 a peace officer license under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, on or
- 23 after January 1, 2022. A person who submits an application for a
- 24 peace officer license under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, before

- 1 January 1, 2022, is governed by the law in effect immediately before
- 2 the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 3 effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
