BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 9

SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is 10

amended by adding Section 39.0239 to read as follows:

12 Sec. 39.0239. ADMINISTRATION OF ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENTS AND

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURES DURING

DISASTER. (a) If a school district is located wholly or partly in

States under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency 16

Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. Section 5121 et seq.) or by the governor 17

under Chapter 418, Government Code, during a school year in which 18

Education for a waiver of the requirement under the Every Student 22

- 2 (b) If the United States Department of Education fails to
- 3 grant a waiver requested under Subsection (a), the assessment
- 4 instruments shall be administered as required under Section 39.023
- 5 during the applicable school year, but, notwithstanding any other
- 6 law, the commissioner may not consider the results of the
- 7 <u>assessment instruments for purposes of:</u>
- 8 (1) evaluating school district or campus performance
- 9 under this chapter for the affected district for the applicable
- 10 school year, including in determining:
- 11 (A) the accreditation status of a district under
- 12 Section 39.051;
- 13 (B) the performance rating to assign to the
- 14 district or the district's campuses under Section 39.054; or
- (C) whether to impose any intervention or
- 16 sanction authorized by Chapter 39A after the applicable school year
- 17 on the district or the district's campuses; or
- 18 (2) determining a student's qualification for
- 19 promotion or graduation.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
