Section 58.106(a), Family Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, information contained in the juvenile justice information system is 8 9 confidential information for the use of the department and may not 10 be disseminated by the department except: 11 (1) with the permission of the juvenile offender, to 12 military personnel of this state or the United States; (2) to a criminal justice agency as defined by Section 13 411.082, Government Code; 14 (3) to a noncriminal justice agency authorized by 15 16 federal statute or federal executive order to receive juvenile 17 justice record information; 18 (4) to a juvenile justice agency; (5) to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department; 19 20 to the office of independent ombudsman of the (6) 21 Texas Juvenile Justice Department; (7) to a district, county, justice, or municipal court 22 23 exercising jurisdiction over a juvenile; and 24 (8) to the Department of Family and Protective

Services or the Health and Human Services Commission as provided by
Section 411.114, Government Code.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
