- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 58.106(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section,
- 8 information contained in the juvenile justice information system is
- 9 confidential information for the use of the department and may not
- 10 be disseminated by the department except:
- 11 (1) with the permission of the juvenile offender, to
- 12 military personnel of this state or the United States;
- 13 (2) to a criminal justice agency as defined by Section
- 14 411.082, Government Code;
- 15 (3) to a noncriminal justice agency authorized by
- 16 federal statute or federal executive order to receive juvenile
- 17 justice record information;
- 18 (4) to a juvenile justice agency;
- 19 (5) to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department;
- 20 (6) to the office of independent ombudsman of the
- 21 Texas Juvenile Justice Department;
- 22 (7) to a district, county, justice, or municipal court
- 23 exercising jurisdiction over a juvenile; and
- 24 (8) to the Department of Family and Protective

- 1 Services or the Health and Human Services Commission as provided by
- 2 Section 411.114, Government Code.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
