- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 481.003(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The director by rule shall prohibit a person in this
- 8 state, including a person regulated by the Texas Department of
- 9 Insurance under the Insurance Code or the other insurance laws of
- 10 this state, <u>a state licensing authority</u>, and a person in the course
- 11 of the person's employment as a pharmacist, from using a
- 12 practitioner's Federal Drug Enforcement Administration number for
- 13 a purpose other than a purpose described by federal law or by this
- 14 chapter. A person who violates a rule adopted under this subsection
- 15 commits a Class C misdemeanor.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 23 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
