4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle E, Title 2, Labor Code, is amended by
6	adding Chapter 94 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 94. REMOTE SERVICE CONTRACTORS
8	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
9	Sec. 94.0001. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as the
10	Remote Service Marketplace Platforms Act.
11	Sec. 94.0002. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
12	(1) "Digital application" means an Internet-connected
13	software application that a person uses to obtain or provide a
14	remote service.
15	(2) "Marketplace company" means a person that:
16	(A) offers a digital application to the public;
17	<u>and</u>
18	(B) accepts requests for remote services
19	exclusively through the person's digital application.
20	(3) "Remote service" means a service designed to
21	assist persons who are deaf or hard of hearing that a persor
22	performs remotely through a digital application. The term includes
23	tutoring, closed captioning, open captioning, subtitling,
24	transcribing, translating, interpreting, and conducting a language

1	assessment remotely through a digital application.
2	(4) "Remote service contractor" means a person who
3	uses a marketplace company's digital application to provide a
4	remote service to another person.
5	SUBCHAPTER B. EMPLOYMENT STATUS
6	Sec. 94.0101. CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH A REMOTE SERVICE
7	CONTRACTOR IS NOT AN EMPLOYEE. (a) A remote service contractor is
8	not an employee of a marketplace company if, under the agreement
9	between the remote service contractor and the marketplace company
10	and in fact:
11	(1) all or substantially all of the work the remote
12	service contractor performs under the agreement:
13	(A) is on a per-job or per-transaction basis; and
14	(B) is compensated on an hourly, per-job, or
15	<pre>per-transaction basis;</pre>
16	(2) the marketplace company does not:
17	(A) prescribe specific hours during which the
18	remote service contractor must be available to accept a request for
19	<pre>remote service;</pre>
20	(B) prescribe a specific location at which the
21	remote service contractor must be available to perform a remote
22	service; or
23	(C) restrict the remote service contractor from
24	engaging in another occupation or business; and
25	(3) except for the use of the marketplace company's
26	digital application, the remote service contractor is responsible
27	for providing the necessary tools materials and equipment to

- 2 marketplace company's digital application.
- 3 (b) A marketplace company's act of screening or training a
- 4 remote service contractor does not affect the remote service
- 5 <u>contractor's employment status under this chapter.</u>
