- 2 relating to deadlines associated with proposing and adopting a
- 3 budget for certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 111.003(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Not later than the 60th day before the first day [During
- 8 the 7th or the 10th month] of the fiscal year, [as determined by the
- 9 commissioners court, the county judge, assisted by the county
- 10 auditor or county clerk, shall prepare a budget to cover all
- 11 proposed expenditures of the county government for the succeeding
- 12 fiscal year.
- SECTION 2. Section 111.006(a), Local Government Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) Not later than the 60th day before the first day of the
- 16 fiscal year [When the county judge has completed the preparation of
- 17 the budget], the county judge shall file a copy of the proposed
- 18 budget with the county clerk.
- SECTION 3. Sections 111.007(b) and (c), Local Government
- 20 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (b) The commissioners court shall hold [set] the hearing not
- 22 later than the 10th [for a date after the 15th] day after [of the
- 23 menth next following] the day [menth in which] the budget is filed
- 24 under [was prepared in accordance with] Section 111.006 [111.003,

- 1 $\frac{\text{Local Government Code}}{\text{Local Government Code}}$, but before the date $\frac{\text{the commissioners court}}{\text{Local Government Code}}$
- 2 adopts the county's ad valorem tax rate for the current tax year [on
- 3 which taxes are levied by the court].
- 4 (c) The commissioners court shall give public notice that it
- 5 will consider the proposed budget on the date of the hearing. The
- 6 notice must state the date, time, and location of the hearing. The
- 7 notice must include, in type of a size at least equal to the type
- 8 used for other items in the notice, any statement required to be
- 9 included in the proposed budget under Section 111.003(b). The
- 10 commissioners court shall give notice under this subsection:
- 11 (1) not earlier than the 30th day before the date of
- 12 the hearing; and
- 13 (2) not later than the 10th day before the date of the
- 14 hearing.
- 15 SECTION 4. Section 111.008(a), Local Government Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) After [At] the conclusion of the public hearing but not
- 18 later than the 10th day before the first day of the fiscal year, the
- 19 commissioners court shall take action on the proposed budget. A
- 20 vote to adopt the budget must be a record vote.
- 21 SECTION 5. Section 111.033(a), Local Government Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) Not later than the 60th day [Within 30 days] before the
- 24 first day of each fiscal year [or on or immediately after that first
- 25 day], the county auditor shall prepare a budget to cover the
- 26 proposed expenditures of the county government for that fiscal
- 27 year.

- 1 SECTION 6. Section 111.037(a), Local Government Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) Not later than the 60th day before the first day of the
- 4 fiscal year, the [The] county auditor shall file a copy of the
- 5 proposed budget with the county clerk.
- 6 SECTION 7. Sections 111.038(b) and (c), Local Government
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The commissioners court shall hold the hearing not later
- 9 than the 10th [on a] day [within 10 calendar days] after the day
- 10 [date] the proposed budget is filed under Section 111.037 but
- 11 before the date the commissioners court adopts the county's ad
- 12 valorem tax rate for the current tax year [the last day of the first
- 13 month of the fiscal year].
- 14 (c) The commissioners court shall publish notice that it
- 15 will consider the proposed budget on the date of the budget hearing.
- 16 The notice must be published once in a newspaper of general
- 17 circulation in the county and must state the date, time, and
- 18 location of the hearing. The commissioners court shall give notice
- 19 under this subsection:
- 20 <u>(1)</u> not earlier than the 30th day before the date of
- 21 the hearing; and
- 22 (2) not later than the 10th day before the date of the
- 23 <u>hearing.</u>
- SECTION 8. Section 111.039(a), Local Government Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) After [At] the conclusion of the public hearing but not
- 27 later than the 10th day before the first day of the fiscal year, the

- 1 commissioners court shall take action on the proposed budget. A
- 2 vote to adopt the budget must be a record vote.
- 3 SECTION 9. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 4 budget proposed by a county commissioners court for a fiscal year
- 5 beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 7 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 8 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 9 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 10 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
