(a) An employer, labor union, or 8 9 employment agency commits an unlawful employment practice if the labor union, or employment agency retaliates 10 employer, or discriminates against a person who, under this chapter: 11 12 (1) opposes a discriminatory practice; 13 (2) makes or files a charge; 14 (3) files a complaint; or testifies, assists, or participates in any manner 15 (4) 16 in an investigation, proceeding, or hearing. (b) An employer, labor union, or employment agency commits 17 an unlawful employment practice if the employer, labor union, or 18 employment agency retaliates or discriminates against a person who 19 engages in lawful conduct involving the exercise of civil rights 20 guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States or of this 21 22 state: 23 (1) during a period of time that is not during the person's assigned working hours; and 24

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(2) in a location that is not the person's work site or
on the premises of the employer, labor union, or employment agency.
SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
to an unlawful employment practice that occurs on or after the
effective date of this Act.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
