- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 51, Local Government Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 51.080 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.080. AUTHORITY TO PROHIBIT ABORTION.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other law, a home-rule municipality by
- 9 ordinance may prohibit a person from performing an abortion, or
- 10 prescribing a medication to induce an abortion, at a location in the
- 11 municipality.

- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Local Government Code,
- 13 is amended by adding Section 54.007 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 54.007. PENALTIES FOR CONDUCT PUNISHABLE UNDER STATE
- 15 LAW. Except as otherwise specifically provided by state law, a
- 16 municipality may not adopt or enforce an ordinance that provides a
- 17 penalty for conduct punishable under state law as a misdemeanor or
- 18 by a civil penalty.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 229.001(a), Local Government Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) Notwithstanding any other law, including Section 43.002
- 22 of this code and Chapter 251, Agriculture Code, a municipality may
- 23 not adopt or enforce regulations relating to:
- 24 (1) the transfer, possession, wearing, carrying,

- 1 ownership, storage, transportation, licensing, or registration of
- 2 firearms, air guns, knives, ammunition, or firearm or air gun
- 3 supplies or accessories;
- 4 (2) commerce in firearms, air guns, knives,
- 5 ammunition, or firearm or air gun supplies or accessories; or
- 6 (3) the discharge of a firearm or air gun at a sport 7 shooting range.
- 8 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to a criminal offense committed or a violation that occurs on or
- 10 after the effective date of this Act. A criminal offense committed
- 11 or a violation that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed
- 13 or the violation occurred, and the former law is continued in effect
- 14 for that purpose. For purposes of this section, a criminal offense
- 15 was committed or a violation occurred before the effective date of
- 16 this Act if any element of the offense or violation occurred before
- 17 that date.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
