A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study and report on the water level of Falcon Lake in
- 3 Zapata and Starr Counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. STUDY. The Parks and Wildlife Department and the
- 6 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall jointly conduct a
- 7 study on the water level of Falcon Lake in Zapata and Starr
- 8 Counties. The study must:
- 9 (1) evaluate the optimum water level for recreational
- 10 fishing on the lake; and
- 11 (2) examine the factors that contribute to or are
- 12 affected by the rise and fall of the lake's water levels, including
- 13 flood control, conservation, and hydroelectric power projects.
- 14 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2022, the
- 15 Parks and Wildlife Department and the Texas Commission on
- 16 Environmental Quality shall submit to the governor, lieutenant
- 17 governor, and speaker of the house of representatives a report that
- 18 includes:
- 19 (1) the findings of the study conducted under Section
- 20 1 of this Act; and
- 21 (2) recommendations to achieve and maintain the
- 22 optimum water level for recreational fishing on Falcon Lake,
- 23 consistent with the purpose of the lake's construction.
- SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires September 1,

- 1 2023.
- 2 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 3 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 4 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 5 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 6 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
