## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a temporary waiver of certain unemployment benefit eligibility conditions and of the recovery of certain improper 3 benefits. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 207, Labor Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 207.0213 to read as follows: Sec. 207.0213. TEMPORARY WAIVER OF CERTAIN ELIGIBILITY 8 9 CONDITIONS. (a) Notwithstanding Section 207.021, if the commission finds that in any seven-day period the number of initial claims 10 filed under this subtitle is more than five times the number of 11 12 initial claims filed under this subtitle in the preceding seven-day period, the commission shall suspend for a period of 30 days the 13 following eligibility conditions to authorize an individual who is 14 otherwise eligible to receive benefits under this subtitle to 15 16 receive those benefits: (1) the condition imposed under Section 207.021(a)(5) 17 that an individual be actively seeking work; and 18 (2) the condition imposed under Section 207.021(a)(8) 19 that an individual have been totally or partially unemployed for a 20 21 waiting period. 22 (b) The period of a suspension imposed under Subsection (a) 23 begins on the first day of the seven-day period in which the increased number of initial claims were filed. 24

1 SECTION 2. Section 214.002, Labor Code, is amended by 2 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

(a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) and except as 3 4 otherwise provided by this subsection, if the commission finds that in any seven-day period the number of initial claims filed under 5 6 this subtitle is more than five times the number of initial claims filed under this subtitle in the preceding seven-day period, the 7 commission may not seek to recover the amount of any improper 8 9 benefits received during the 30-day period beginning on the first day of the seven-day period in which the increased number of initial 10 claims were filed. This subsection does not apply to improper 11 benefits obtained by a person due to a nondisclosure or 12 misrepresentation that is known or fraudulent. 13

14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
