6	SECTION 1. Chapter 434, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Subchapter J to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER J. BENEFITS, RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, AND IMMUNITIES OF
9	CERTAIN VETERANS
10	Sec. 434.451. CERTAIN PERSONS CONSIDERED HONORABLY
11	DISCHARGED. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, a person is
12	considered to have been honorably discharged from the armed forces
13	of the United States or the Texas military forces for purposes of
14	state law if the person was dishonorably discharged solely on the
15	basis of the person's sexual orientation or gender identity.
16	(b) A person considered to have been honorably discharged
17	under Subsection (a) is entitled to all benefits, rights,
18	privileges, and immunities provided by state law to an honorably
19	discharged veteran.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
