- the officer with the person's name, residence address, and date of birth, and the person may not refuse to provide the requested information to the officer. A person who refuses to give to an officer information requested under this subsection commits an
- 14 offense under Section 38.02, Penal Code. Each law enforcement
- 15 agency shall adopt a written policy regarding the collection of
- 16 <u>information under this subsection.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
