- 2 Art. 42.25. PERMANENT RELINQUISHMENT OF ANIMALS FOR
- 3 REPEATED ANIMAL CRUELTY OFFENSES. For a defendant convicted of an

- 5 condition of punishment, require the defendant to permanently
- 6 relinquish custody of any animals in the defendant's possession.
- 7 SECTION 3. Article 42A.511(c), Code of Criminal Procedure,
