## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the adjustment of the average daily attendance of a
- 3 school district due to a disaster that disrupts in-person
- 4 attendance.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 48.006, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsections (b) and (c) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the commissioner
- 10 shall adjust the average daily attendance of a school district all
- 11 or part of which is located in an area of a disaster declared by the
- 12 president of the United States under the Robert T. Stafford
- 13 <u>Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. Section</u>
- 14 5121 et seq.) or by the governor under Chapter 418, Government Code,
- 15 if in-person attendance in the district is disrupted for at least
- 16 <u>37,800</u> consecutive instructional minutes due to the disaster.
- 17 (b) An [The] adjustment under Subsection (a) or (a-1) must
- 18 be sufficient to ensure that the district receives funding
- 19 comparable to the funding that the district would have received if
- 20 the decline in average daily attendance reasonably attributable to
- 21 the impact of the disaster had not occurred.
- (c) The commissioner may make the adjustment under
- 23 Subsection (a) [this section] for the two-year period following the
- 24 date of the governor's initial proclamation or executive order

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- 1 declaring the state of disaster.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
