- 2 relating to an allotment under the public school finance system for
- 3 medically fragile students.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 48, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 48.117 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 48.117. ALLOTMENT FOR MEDICALLY FRAGILE STUDENTS. (a)
- 8 For each student that a school district serves who has been
- 9 identified as medically fragile, the district is entitled to an
- 10 annual allotment equal to the basic allotment multiplied by 0.1 or a
- 11 greater amount provided by appropriation.
- 12 (b) A school district may receive funding for a student
- 13 under this section and Section 48.102 if the student satisfies the
- 14 requirements of both sections.
- 15 (c) A school district may use the allotment provided for a
- 16 qualifying student under this section to contract with a private
- 17 provider to provide supplemental services, including private duty
- 18 <u>nursing services</u>, to the student.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
