- 2 relating to the content of an application for Medicaid.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 32.025(g), Human Resources Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (g) The application form adopted under this section must
- 7 include:
- 8 (1) for an applicant who is pregnant, a question
- 9 regarding whether the pregnancy is the woman's first gestational
- 10 pregnancy; and
- 11 (2) for all applicants, a question regarding the
- 12 applicant's preferences for being contacted, as follows:
- "If you are determined eligible for benefits, your
- 14 managed care organization or health plan provider may contact you
- 15 by telephone, text message, or e-mail about health care matters,
- 16 including reminders for appointments and information about
- 17 immunizations or well check visits. All preferred methods of
- 18 contact listed on this application will be shared with your managed
- 19 care organization or health plan provider.
- If your preferred method of contact about health
- 21 care matters is by electronic communication, including text message
- 22 or e-mail, please be advised that while your managed care
- 23 organization or health plan provider is required to protect the
- 24 security of that communication, because electronic communication

- 1 may not be encrypted there is still a risk of a security breach,
- 2 including the risk of confidential or private information being
- 3 intercepted by an unauthorized third party. By completing the form
- 4 below, you acknowledge that you understand the risks associated
- 5 with and consent to the use of electronic communication.

- 21 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, the executive
- 22 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 23 adopt a revised application form for medical assistance benefits
- 24 that conforms to the requirements of Section 32.025(g), Human
- 25 Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 27 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

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- 1 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 2 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 3 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 4 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
