- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 33.0331 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.0331. DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT. (a) Subject to
- 8 Subsection (b), the commission shall dismiss each complaint filed
- 9 with the commission that the commission has not formally dismissed
- 10 or for which the commission has not imposed sanctions or instituted
- 11 proceedings on or before the first Monday following the 365th day
- 12 after the date the commission receives the complaint.
- 13 (b) The chairperson may determine on the executive
- 14 director's recommendation that extenuating circumstances require
- 15 additional time not to exceed 120 days for disposal of a complaint
- 16 that is subject to dismissal under Subsection (a).
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 33.0331, Government Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, applies only to a complaint filed with the State
- 19 Commission on Judicial Conduct on or after the effective date of
- 20 this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
