- 7 Sec. 33.0331. DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT. (a) Subject to
- 8 Subsection (b), the commission shall dismiss each complaint filed
- 9 with the commission that the commission has not formally dismissed
- 10 or for which the commission has not imposed sanctions or instituted
- 11 proceedings on or before the first Monday following the 455th day
- 12 after the date the commission receives the complaint.
- 13 (b) The chairperson may determine on the executive
- 14 director's recommendation that extenuating circumstances,
- 15 including a need for further investigation, require additional time
- 16 not to exceed 120 days for disposal of a complaint that is subject
- 17 <u>to dismissal under Subsection (a).</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 33.0331, Government Code, as added by
