- 12 liquor at retail for off-premise consumption at a cost less than the
- 13 <u>retailer's cost.</u>

- 14 (c) Proof of the retailer's cost for wine or liquor shall:
- 15 (1) become a part of the permanent records of each
- 16 person who holds a permit authorizing the retail sale of wine or
- 17 liquor for off-premise consumption; and
- 18 <u>(2) be available for a period of two years for</u>
- 19 <u>inspection by the commission.</u>
- 20 (d) This section does not apply to the sale of a specific
- 21 wine or liquor product if the manufacturer of the product has
- 22 discontinued the production, importation, special packaging, or
