## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the use of executory contracts for the purchase of land

3 to be used as a residence in certain counties.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 5.0622 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5.0622. ADDITIONAL APPLICABILITY: CERTAIN COUNTIES.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to a county with a population of less
- 9 than 100,000 that is located in a metropolitan statistical area as
- 10 defined by the federal Office of Management and Budget:
- 11 (1) with a population of more than 1.5 million; and
- 12 (2) adjacent to a different metropolitan statistical
- 13 area as defined by the federal Office of Management and Budget with
- 14 a population of more than 2 million.
- 15 (b) The commissioners court of a county may adopt an order
- 16 requiring an executory contract for the conveyance of land
- 17 measuring 20 acres or less used or to be used as a residence located
- 18 in the county to be subject to this subchapter. The order must
- 19 specify a method for determining whether the land is used or to be
- 20 used as a residence.

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- 21 <u>(c) The order may not include an executory contract for the</u>
- 22 conveyance of land:
- 23 (1) described by Section 5.062(d); or
- 24 (2) that is to be used primarily for agricultural use,

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- 1 as defined by Section 1-d, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, or for
- 2 farm, ranch, wildlife management, or timber production use within
- 3 the meaning of Section 1-d-1, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, and
- 4 for which no part of the land is to be used as a residence.
- 5 (d) If a tract described by Subsection (c)(2) ceases to be
- 6 used primarily for agricultural use or for farm, ranch, wildlife
- 7 management, or timber production use, or any part of the land is
- 8 used as a residence, the executory contract for the conveyance of
- 9 the land may be included in an order authorized by this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Property Code, is
- 11 amended by adding Section 5.087 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 5.087. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS: CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a)
- 13 This section applies only to a county adopting an order under
- 14 Section 5.0622.
- 15 (b) The commissioners court may not modify the provisions of
- 16 this subchapter except the commissioners court may provide in the
- 17 order that:
- 18 (1) an executory contract to which the order applies
- 19 may not be used to purchase land unless the land meets a minimum
- 20 frontage requirement on a public road or a private road as specified
- 21 <u>in the order; and</u>
- 22 (2) the conversion authorized by Section 5.081 is
- 23 required to occur not later than three years after the date the
- 24 executory contract is entered into.
- 25 SECTION 3. Sections 5.0622 and 5.087, Property Code, as
- 26 added by this Act, apply only to an executory contract entered into
- 27 on or after the date the commissioners court adopts an order

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- 1 authorized by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
