13	[(2)] in <u>the unincorporated area of</u> an affected		
14	county, as defined by Section 16.341, Water Code, that:		
15	(A) has adopted the model rules developed under		
16	Section 16.343, Water Code: $[-\tau]$ and		
17	(B) is located along an international border; and		
18	(2) if the area is located in the extraterritorial		
19	jurisdiction of a municipality, is not subject to a written		
20	agreement under Section 242.001 that authorizes the municipality to		
21	regulate subdivision plats and approve related permits in the		
22	extraterritorial jurisdiction.		
23	(g) Notwithstanding Section 232.0015(b) or any other law,		
24	this section applies to a subdivision of land to which Subchapter B
