2	relating to the authority of certain counties to remediate an
3	overflow of water caused by a diversion or impoundment of the

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 11.086, Water Code, is amended by adding
7	Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
8	(e) In a county with a population of more than 312,000 and
9	less than 330,000, the commissioners court by order may require the
10	county to:
11	(1) remediate an overflow of water caused by a
12	diversion or impoundment of the natural flow of surface water as
13	necessary to mitigate the effects of a natural disaster; or
14	(2) remediate an overflow of water caused by a
15	diversion or impoundment of the natural flow of surface water in
16	violation of Subsection (a) if:
17	(A) the commissioners court sends notice to the
18	person who is in violation of Subsection (a):
19	(i) informing the person of the violation;
20	and
21	(ii) requiring the person to remediate the
22	violation not later than the 30th day after the date of receipt of
23	the notice; and
24	(B) after receiving notice under Paragraph (A),

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1 the person does not remedy the violation in the specified time.

2 (f) A county is not liable for damages caused by an action
3 taken pursuant to an order issued under Subsection (e).

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
