CONSIDERATION OF LOCATION OF BIDDER'S 8 9 PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR AWARDING CERTAIN COUNTY CONTRACTS. (a) This section applies only to a county with a population of more 10 than 3.3 million. 11 12 (b) A county may award a contract for services or for the 13 construction, repair, or renovation of a structure, road, highway, 14 or other improvement or addition to real property to a bidder whose principal place of business is in the county if: 15 16 (1) the bid or proposed price submitted by the bidder is within three percent of the lowest bid or proposed price received 17 by the county from a bidder with the ability to perform the contract 18 that does not have a principal place of business in the county; and 19 (2) the commissioners court determines, in writing, 20 that the bid or proposal of the bidder offers the county the best 21 combination of contract price, ability to perform the contract, 22 23 and additional economic development opportunities for the county created by the contract award, including the employment of 24

1 residents of the county and increased tax revenues to the county.

2 (c) This section does not prohibit a county from rejecting 3 all bids.

4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a contract for which a county first advertises or otherwise 5 solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications or makes a 6 similar solicitation on or after the effective date of this Act. A 7 8 contract for which a county first advertises or otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications or makes a similar 9 solicitation before the effective date of this Act is governed by 10 the law in effect on the date the advertisement or solicitation was 11 made, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 12

13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
