- 2 relating to restoring electric service to certain vulnerable
- 3 customers after a power outage.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 38.0725 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 38.0725. PRIORITIES FOR POWER RESTORATION TO CERTAIN
- 8 CUSTOMERS. (a) The commission by rule shall require each retail
- 9 electric provider to implement a process by which a customer of the
- 10 provider may report to the provider that the customer has a serious
- 11 medical condition that requires an electric-powered device.
- 12 (b) A retail electric provider shall maintain customer
- 13 <u>information reported under this section to allow the retail</u>
- 14 electric provider to quickly identify vulnerable customers during a
- 15 power outage and notify the relevant transmission and distribution
- 16 utilities to prioritize those customers for power restoration.
- 17 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 18 of this Act, the Public Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt the
- 19 rules required by Section 38.0725, Utilities Code, as added by this
- 20 Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
