A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a landlord's liability to a tenant for a casualty loss to residential rental premises caused by the landlord. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 92.054, Property Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows: 6 (d) If the rental premises become unusable for residential 7 purposes as a result of a casualty loss caused by the negligence or 8 9 fault of the landlord, the landlord: (1) if comparable rental premises owned by the 10 landlord are available for occupancy, shall allow the tenant to 11 12 move to the premises for the remainder of the tenant's lease; or (2) if rental premises owned by the landlord are not 13 14 available, shall: 15 (A) locate comparable rental premises; and 16 (B) be liable to the tenant for the amount of the rent for the comparable rental premises that exceeds the amount of 17 rent the tenant pays to the landlord under the tenant's lease for 18 the remainder of the tenant's lease. 19 (e) The duties of a landlord under Subsection (d) are in 20 addition to any other duties of a landlord or remedies of a tenant 21 under this subchapter. 22 SECTION 2. Section 92.054(d), Property Code, as added by 23 this Act, applies only to a lease that is executed or renewed on or 24

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1 after the effective date of this Act. A lease that is executed or 2 renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 3 in effect at the time the lease was executed or renewed, and that 4 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
