- 5 SECTION 1. Section 383.002, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 383.002. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. This chapter furthers
- 8 the public purpose of developing and diversifying the economy of
- 9 the counties of this state by providing incentives for the location
- 10 and development of projects [in certain counties] to attract
- 11 visitors and tourists.
- 12 SECTION 2. Sections 383.003(a) and (b), Local Government
- 13 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Counties [Small and medium-sized counties] in this
- 15 state need incentives for the development of public improvements to
- 16 attract visitors and tourists. Counties in this state [to those
- 17 counties, and those counties] are at a disadvantage in competing
- 18 with counties in other states for the location and development of
- 19 projects that attract visitors by virtue of the availability and
- 20 prevalent use of financial incentives in other states.
- 21 (b) The means and measures authorized by this chapter are in
- 22 the public interest and serve a public purpose of this state in
- 23 promoting the economic welfare of the residents of this state by
- 24 providing incentives for the location and development [in certain

- 1 counties of this state] of projects that attract visitors and
- 2 tourists and that result in employment and economic activity.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 383.021(a), Local Government Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The commissioners court of a county [with a population
- 6  $\frac{\text{of } 400,000 \text{ or less}}{\text{of } 100,000 \text{ or less}}$ ], on petition of the owners of land in a proposed
- 7 district, may commence the creation of a county development
- 8 district.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
