## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to design considerations of transportation projects by the
3	Texas Department of Transportation.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 201.615, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a) The department shall consider the following factors
9	when developing transportation projects that involve the
10	construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, or resurfacing of a
11	highway, other than a maintenance resurfacing project:
12	(1) the extent to which the project promotes safety;
13	(2) the durability of the project;
14	(3) the economy of maintenance of the project;
15	(4) the impact of the project on:
16	(A) the natural and artificial environment;
17	(B) the scenic and aesthetic character of the
18	area in which the project is located;
19	(C) preservation efforts; and
20	(D) each affected local community and its
21	economy;
22	(5) the access for other modes of transportation,
23	including those that promote physically active communities; [and]
24	(6) except as provided by Subsection (c), the

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- 1 aesthetic character of the project, including input from each
- 2 affected local community;
- 3 (7) except as provided by Subsection (d), an
- 4 alternative design for the project that has been approved by a vote
- 5 of the governing body of a municipality that represents an affected
- 6 local community; and
- 7 (8) the negative impacts to an affected local
- 8 community from previous transportation projects.
- 9 (d) Subsection (a)(7) does not apply to a transportation
- 10 project if the department finds that an alternative design for a
- 11 transportation project approved by the governing body of a
- 12 municipality is frivolous, unreasonable, or intended to delay a
- 13 transportation project.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
