A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the identification of and prohibited cooperation by
3	state and local entities with certain federal acts that violate the

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by adding
7	Chapter 793 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 793. IDENTIFICATION OF AND PROHIBITED COOPERATION WITH
9	CERTAIN UNCONSTITUTIONAL ACTS OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT
10	Sec. 793.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Political subdivision" has the meaning assigned
12	by Section 791.003.
13	(2) "State agency" has the meaning assigned by Section
14	<u>751.001.</u>
15	Sec. 793.002. REVIEW OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) On the last
16	day of each month, the attorney general shall provide a written
17	report to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house
18	of representatives, and each member of the legislature that:
19	(1) identifies each rule adopted by a federal
20	government agency during the previous month that:
21	(A) relates to:
22	(i) freedom of speech;
23	(ii) the freedom to assemble;
24	(iii) the freedom to petition the

2	(iv) the freedom of the press;
3	(v) the free exercise of religion,
4	including the congregating of religious practitioners;
5	(vi) the right of the people to keep and
6	bear arms;
7	(vii) the regulation of the agriculture
8	<pre>industry;</pre>
9	(viii) the use of land;
10	(ix) the regulation of natural resources,
11	including oil and natural gas;
12	(x) the regulation of education;
13	(xi) the regulation of interscholastic,
14	intramural, or other extracurricular sports sponsored by an
15	institution of higher education, a school district, or a charter
16	school;
17	(xii) powers not specifically granted to
18	the federal government by the United States Constitution;
19	(B) was adopted in response to an executive order
20	by the president of the United States; and
21	(C) violates the rights guaranteed to the
22	citizens of the United States by the United States Constitution or
23	exceeds the powers specifically granted to the federal government
24	by the United States Constitution; and
25	(2) provides the status of any lawsuit filed against
26	the federal government relating to a rule identified by any report
27	prepared under this section, including whether a court has found

- 1 the rule to:
- 2 (A) violate the rights guaranteed to the citizens
- 3 of the United States by the United States Constitution; or
- 4 (B) exceed the powers specifically granted to the
- 5 federal government by the United States Constitution.
- 6 (b) The attorney general shall publish any report prepared
- 7 under this section on the attorney general's website and in the
- 8 Texas Register.
- 9 Sec. 793.003. COOPERATION WITH UNCONSTITUTIONAL ACTS.
- 10 Notwithstanding any other law, a state agency or political
- 11 subdivision may not cooperate with a federal government agency in
- 12 implementing an agency rule that a report published under Section
- 13 793.002 indicates:
- 14 (1) violates the rights guaranteed to the citizens of
- 15 the United States by the United States Constitution; or
- (2) exceeds the powers specifically granted to the
- 17 federal government by the United States Constitution.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
