Subchapter E, Chapter 228, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 228.202 to read as follows: 10 11 Sec. 228.202. TOLLS PROHIBITED ON PORTIONS OF STATE HIGHWAY 12 146 AND STATE HIGHWAY 99. The department may not charge a toll, either directly or indirectly through an agreement with another 13 entity, on: 14 (1) the portion of State Highway 146 that crosses the 15 16 Houston Ship Channel; or (2) the portion of State Highway 99 between its 17

- intersection with State Highway 146 and its intersection with 18
- 19 Interstate 10.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 24
