7	Sec. 39.159. ACCESS TO WHOLESALE POWER AND TRANSMISSION
8	SERVICE OUTSIDE ERCOT. Notwithstanding any other law, a
9	municipally owned utility that transmits or distributes power
10	purchased at wholesale in ERCOT may make requests, obtain
11	approvals, enter into contracts, and construct facilities as
12	necessary to:
13	(1) access transmission service from outside of ERCOT;
14	and
15	(2) purchase power at wholesale from outside of ERCOT.
16	SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2022, the Public
17	Utility Commission of Texas shall examine the laws and rules
18	governing electric utilities in this state to determine how Section
19	39.159, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, may affect the
20	application of those laws and rules and shall adopt recommendations

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for legislative and administrative action as necessary to implement
