A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to validating certain acts and proceedings of the East
- 3 Lake Houston Management District and to the authority of the
- 4 district to exercise certain powers, issue bonds, and impose fees,
- 5 taxes, and assessments.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 3936, Special District
- 8 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 3936.113 to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 Sec. 3936.113. PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT POWERS. The
- 11 district has the powers provided by Chapter 372, Local Government
- 12 Code, to a municipality or county.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 3936, Special District
- 14 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 3936.162 to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 Sec. 3936.162. CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY NOT EXEMPT.
- 17 Section 375.161, Local Government Code, does not apply to the
- 18 <u>district.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 3936.204, Special District Local Laws
- 20 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 21 (d) The district may issue, by public or private sale,
- 22 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from
- 23 assessments in the manner provided by Subchapter A, Chapter 372,
- 24 Local Government Code, if the improvements financed by an

- 1 obligation issued under this section will be conveyed to, operated
- 2 and maintained by, or otherwise financed pursuant to an agreement
- 3 between the district and the county, a municipality, or a retail
- 4 utility provider entered into before the issuance of the
- 5 obligation.
- 6 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 7 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 8 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 9 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 10 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 11 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 12 Government Code.
- 13 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 14 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 15 Environmental Quality.
- 16 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 17 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
- 18 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
- 19 within the required time.
- 20 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 21 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 22 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
- 23 fulfilled and accomplished.
- SECTION 5. (a) The following are validated and confirmed in
- 25 all respects:
- 26 (1) the creation of the East Lake Houston Management
- 27 District; and

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- 1 (2) any act or proceeding of the district, including
- 2 an election, not excepted by this section and taken not more than
- 3 three years before the effective date of this Act, effective as of
- 4 the date on which the act or proceeding occurred.
- 5 (b) This section does not apply to:
- 6 (1) an act, proceeding, director, other official,
- 7 bond, or other obligation the validity of which or of whom is the
- 8 subject of litigation that is pending on the effective date of this
- 9 Act; or
- 10 (2) an act or proceeding that, under a statute of this
- 11 state or the United States, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time
- 12 the act or proceeding occurred.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
