| 19 | the county attorney in Ector County to represent the state, Ector |
| 20 | County, and the officials of the county in all civil matters, other |
| 21 | than asset forfeiture and bond forfeiture matters for which the |
| 22 | district attorney is responsible, pending before the courts of |
| 23 | Ector County and any other court in which the state, Ector County, |

(b) The county attorney has no power, duty, or privilege in 1 2 Ector County relating to criminal matters, juvenile matters under Title 3, Family Code, or matters involving children's protective 3 4 services. SECTION 3. Section 43.137, Government Code, as amended by 5 6 this Act, and Section 45.168, Government Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a proceeding commenced on or after the effective date 7 8 of this Act. A proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding 9 was commenced, and the former law is continued in effect for that 10

- 11 purpose.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
