H.B. No. 4633

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of the Grayson County Municipal Utility District No. 9; granting a limited power of eminent domain; 3 providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose 4 5 assessments, fees, and taxes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7936A to read as follows: 8 9 CHAPTER 7936A. GRAYSON COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 9 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 10 Sec. 7936A.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 11 12 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors. (2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on 13 14 Environmental Quality. "Director" means a board member. 15 (3) 16 (4) "District" means the Grayson County Municipal 17 Utility District No. 9. Sec. 7936A.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a 18 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, 19 Texas Constitution. 20 21 Sec. 7936A.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTOR ELECTION REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to 22 23 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code. 24

Sec. 7936A.0104. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 7936A.0103 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

Sec. 7936A.0105. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. 7 8 (a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit. 9 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of: (1) a municipal utility district as provided by 10 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and 11 12 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation, 13 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 14 15 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

Sec. 7936A.0106. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is initially composed of the territory described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

19 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of 20 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the 21 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process 22 does not affect the district's:

(1) organization, existence, or validity;

24 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes 25 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and 26 interest on a bond;

27 (3) right to impose a tax; or

2	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
3	Sec. 7936A.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district
4	is governed by a board of five elected directors.
5	(b) Except as provided by Section 7936A.0202, directors
6	serve staggered four-year terms.
7	Sec. 7936A.0202. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after
8	September 1, 2021, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed
9	value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to
10	the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary
11	directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission
12	shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the
13	petition.
14	(b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:
15	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
16	Section 7936A.0103; or
17	(2) September 1, 2025.
18	(c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
19	Section 7936A.0103 and the terms of the temporary directors have
20	expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
21	reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
22	expire on the earlier of:
23	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
24	Section 7936A.0103; or
25	(2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
26	appointment or reappointment.
27	(d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a

1 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district 2 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five 3 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as 4 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 5 6 petition. 7 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES 8 Sec. 7936A.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for 9 10 which the district is created. Sec. 7936A.0302. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 11 12 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, 13 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, 14 Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 15 Sec. 7936A.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under 16 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may 17 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, 18 19 operate, maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a 20 municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or improvements, including storm drainage, in aid 21 22 of those roads. 23 Sec. 7936A.0304. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 24 road project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each 25 26 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial 27 jurisdiction the road project is located.

No. 4633 1 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits 2 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road project must meet all applicable construction standards, 3 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which 4 5 the road project is located. (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the 6 7 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and 8 specifications of the road project. Sec. 7936A.0305. COMPLIANCE 9 WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all 10 applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is 11 12 adopted under Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land 13 14 in the district. 15 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS 16 Sec. 7936A.0401. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) 17 The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other obligations secured by: 18 19 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or 20 (2) contract payments described by Section 7936A.0403. 21 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner 22 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval 23 24 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes. 25 26 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a 27

1	vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
2	election held for that purpose.
3	Sec. 7936A.0402. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
4	authorized at an election held under Section 7936A.0401, the
5	district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable
6	property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water
7	<u>Code.</u>
8	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
9	exceed the rate approved at the election.
10	Sec. 7936A.0403. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
11	Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
12	an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
13	the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
14	the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
15	voting at an election held for that purpose.
16	(b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
17	provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
18	the board without further voter approval.
19	SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
20	Sec. 7936A.0501. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
21	OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
22	payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
23	revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any
24	combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
25	purpose.
26	Sec. 7936A.0502. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
27	issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the

1 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing 2 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all 3 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner 4 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code. 5 Sec. 7936A.0503. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of 6 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations 7 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad

8 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the 9 real property in the district.

10 SECTION 2. The Grayson County Municipal Utility District 11 No. 9 initially includes all the territory contained in the 12 following area:

14 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 15 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 16 17 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 18 19 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. 20

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives within the required time.

1 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 2 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 3 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 4 and accomplished.

5 SECTION 4. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds 6 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter 7 7936A, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of 8 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7936A.0306 to read as 9 follows:

10 <u>Sec. 7936A.0306. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may</u> 11 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

(b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c), Article I, Texas Constitution.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
