A magistrate has concurrent 16 criminal jurisdiction with: 17 18 (1) the judges of the justice of the peace courts of Burnet County; and 19 20 (2) a municipal court in Burnet County, if approved by 21 a memorandum of understanding between the municipality and Burnet 22 County. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24
