- 2 relating to the powers of the Hidalgo County Drainage District
- 3 Number 1; authorizing the issuance of bonds.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. In this Act, "district" means the Hidalgo County
- 6 Drainage District Number 1.
- 7 SECTION 2. (a) District revenue bonds may be secured as
- 8 described by a board resolution by a pledge of:
- 9 (1) all or part of the district's gross revenue, other
- 10 than taxation, minus the amount necessary to pay the cost of
- 11 maintaining and operating the district and its property;
- 12 (2) the net revenue of a contract made at any time; or
- 13 (3) other revenue specified by board resolution.
- 14 (b) The pledge may reserve the right to issue additional
- 15 bonds on a parity with or subordinate to the bonds being issued,
- 16 subject to conditions specified by the pledge.
- 17 (c) District revenue bonds not payable wholly or partly from
- 18 ad valorem taxes may be issued without an election.
- 19 SECTION 3. (a) The district may sell reclaimed water at
- 20 wholesale and sell reclaimed water on a retail basis to the extent
- 21 that the sale does not conflict with a certificate of convenience
- 22 and necessity.
- 23 (b) The district may enter into public-private partnership
- 24 agreements to fund infrastructure improvements needed to sell

- 1 reclaimed water to consumers.
- 2 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 3 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 4 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 5 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 6 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 7 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 8 Government Code.
- 9 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 10 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 11 Environmental Quality.
- 12 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 13 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 14 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 15 representatives within the required time.
- 16 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 17 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 18 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 19 and accomplished.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
