HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Lone Star State has borne sorrowful witness to

- 2 some of the nation's worst mass shootings; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In August 1966, a sniper killed 15 people on The
- 4 University of Texas at Austin campus; the unprecedented carnage
- 5 shocked the nation, and the Associated Press and United Press
- 6 International ranked it as the second most important story of the
- 7 year, after the Vietnam War; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Tragically, mass shootings have become almost
- 9 commonplace; over the past decade, dozens of Texans have been
- 10 killed in such massacres, including two that occurred back-to-back
- 11 in 2019; the slaughter at an El Paso Walmart in August claimed 23
- 12 lives, and a murderous spree across Midland-Odessa took seven more
- 13 later that month; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Santa Fe High School lost eight students and two
- 15 teachers in a 2018 shooting; the year before, a gunman opened fire
- 16 at the First Baptist Church in Sutherland Springs, slaying 25
- 17 worshippers; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The victims of these savage attacks deserve to be
- 19 remembered; under Chapter 443, Government Code, and rules of the
- 20 State Preservation Board, a portion of the north Capitol grounds is
- 21 available for new monuments, subject to legislative approval,
- 22 specified procedural requirements, the provision of funding from
- 23 private donors, conformity to certain size and design limitations
- 24 and parameters, and completion on a timely basis; and

- 1 WHEREAS, A memorial on the Capitol grounds would provide a
- 2 communal place for Texans to honor the innocent lives cut short by
- 3 mass gun violence, and many citizens stand ready to donate funds for
- 4 such a project; now, therefore, be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 6 hereby authorize the State Preservation Board, subject to state law
- 7 and rules of the board, to approve and permit the construction of a
- 8 monument at the state Capitol Complex, at a site outside the
- 9 historic Capitol grounds, honoring victims of mass shootings; and,
- 10 be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward an
- 12 official copy of this resolution to the executive director of the
- 13 State Preservation Board.
