## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, CTE Letter of Intent Signing Day is held each year at
- 2 schools across the country to honor students who have chosen to
- 3 pursue career and technical education as a means of acquiring
- 4 real-world skills to compete in the workforce; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Similar to the signing day celebrations that are
- 6 held when young athletes declare which college they will attend,
- 7 CTE Letter of Intent Signing Day recognizes the important
- 8 commitment that career and technical education students are making
- 9 by undertaking these studies; and
- WHEREAS, Around 12.5 million American high school and college
- 11 students are enrolled in CTE courses, which encompass a variety of
- 12 occupational fields, including agriculture, construction,
- 13 manufacturing, computer science, and health care; and
- 14 WHEREAS, In addition to gaining specific career-related
- 15 knowledge, participants in CTE programs learn such essential skills
- 16 as time management, problem solving, and critical thinking, which
- 17 better prepare them for the challenges and opportunities of the
- 18 workplace; these programs motivate and engage students by providing
- 19 hands-on activities in which they can further their expertise and
- 20 interact with community members, potential employers, and students
- 21 and teachers who share their vocational interests; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Career and technical education is offering a path to
- 23 success in the 21st-century economy while helping to address the
- 24 urgent need for skilled labor in high-demand industries, and it is

- 3 RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 4 hereby designate the first Friday in May as Career and Technical
- 5 Education Letter of Intent Signing Day; and, be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 7 391.004(d), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
- 8 until the 10th anniversary of the date that this resolution is
- 9 finally passed by the legislature.
