CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Shelby Landgraf is the recipient of a 2021 West
2 Texas Women of Distinction Award from the Girl Scouts of the Desert
3 Southwest; and

4 WHEREAS, The Girl Scouts of the Desert Southwest connects
5 nearly 3,800 girls across West Texas and Southern New Mexico; the
6 council's Women of Distinction Award recognizes women whose
7 extraordinary contributions to their communities exemplify the
8 organization's mission of developing leaders of courage,
9 confidence, and strong character; and

10 WHEREAS, A proud "military brat," Shelby Landgraf grew up all
11 over the world and spent part of every summer in West Texas; after
12 earning her bachelor's degree in speech communication and business
13 administration from Trinity University, she embarked on a
14 successful career in broadcast journalism; and

16 Antonio and a reporter and weekend anchor in North Texas and
17 Oklahoma before joining CBS7 in Odessa as the co-anchor of the
18 evening news; despite her busy schedule, she finds time to give back
19 as a member of the board of the West Texas Food Bank and the advisory
20 board of the John Ben Shepperd Public Leadership Institute and as a
21 volunteer at her daughter's school; and

23 Distinction Award, Shelby Landgraf joins an elite group of civic
24 leaders who have been honored by the Girl Scouts of the Desert

1 Southwest, and she is indeed a worthy role model for this and future
