A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing Webb County to
- 2 delegate its authority to manage and dispose of county school land
- 3 and invest and manage the proceeds from the county permanent school
- 4 fund.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 6, Article VII, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 6. (a) All lands heretofore, or hereafter granted to
- 9 the several counties of this State for educational purposes, are of
- 10 right the property of said counties respectively, to which they
- 11 were granted, and title thereto is vested in said counties, and no
- 12 adverse possession or limitation shall ever be available against
- 13 the title of any county. Each county may sell or dispose of its
- 14 lands in whole or in part, in manner to be provided by the
- 15 Commissioners Court of the county. Said lands, and, except as
- 16 provided by Subsection (b) of this section, the proceeds thereof,
- 17 when sold, shall be held by said counties alone as a trust for the
- 18 benefit of public schools therein; said proceeds to be invested in
- 19 bonds of the United States, the State of Texas, or counties in said
- 20 State, or in such other securities, and under such restrictions as
- 21 may be prescribed by law; and the counties shall be responsible for
- 22 all investments; the interest thereon, and other revenue, except
- 23 the principal shall be available fund.
- (b) Webb County may enter into an agreement with the school

- 1 districts for which Webb County holds lands in trust under this
- 2 section under which Webb County delegates to a committee whose
- 3 membership consists of members of the boards of trustees of the
- 4 school districts to:
- 5 (1) sell, lease, manage, or otherwise dispose of the
- 6 lands held in trust;
- 7 (2) develop or sell the rights to natural resources or
- 8 minerals in the lands held in trust; and
- 9 (3) invest and manage all or part of the proceeds of
- 10 Webb County's permanent school fund.
- 11 (c) The proceeds from a disposition of land authorized under
- 12 Subsection (b) of this section shall be held by Webb County as a
- 13 trust for the benefit of the school districts as provided by
- 14 Subsection (a) of this section.
- 15 (d) The committee described in Subsection (b) of this
- 16 section shall consist of one trustee appointed by each of the school
- 17 districts for which the lands are held in trust by Webb County under
- 18 this section. Additional trustees from each school district shall
- 19 be appointed to the committee based on the school district's
- 20 average daily attendance at a rate of one trustee per 15,000
- 21 students.
- 22 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 23 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 24 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 25 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize Webb
- 26 County to enter into an agreement to delegate its authority
- 27 regarding the management and disposition of county school lands

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- 1 from Webb County to the school districts for which the lands are
- 2 held in trust and to delegate its authority to invest and manage
- 3 proceeds of Webb County's permanent school fund from Webb County to
- 4 the school districts for which the lands are held in trust."
