A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for annual
- 2 legislative sessions.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 5(a) and (b), Article III, Texas
- 5 Constitution, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The Legislature shall meet every year in regular session
- 7 [two years] at such time as may be provided by law and at other times
- 8 when convened by the Governor.
- 9 (b) When convened in regular $\underline{session}$ [$\underline{Session}$], the first $\underline{15}$
- 10 [thirty] days thereof shall be devoted to the introduction of bills
- 11 and resolutions, acting upon emergency appropriations, passing
- 12 upon the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor and
- 13 such emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in
- 14 special messages to the Legislature. During the succeeding 15
- 15 [thirty] days of the regular session of the Legislature the various
- 16 committees of each House shall hold hearings to consider all bills
- 17 and resolutions and other matters then pending; and such emergency
- 18 matters as may be submitted by the Governor. During the remainder
- 19 of the session the Legislature shall act upon such bills and
- 20 resolutions as may be then pending and upon such emergency matters
- 21 as may be submitted by the Governor in special messages to the
- 22 Legislature.
- SECTION 2. Section 24(b), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 24 is amended to read as follows:

- 1 (b) No Regular Session shall be of longer duration than 70 2 [one hundred and forty (140)] days.
- 3 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 4 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 5 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 6 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for annual
- 7 legislative sessions."
