A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail
- 2 to an accused person if necessary to ensure the person's appearance
- 3 in court and the safety of the community and of any person,
- 4 including the victim of the alleged offense.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 11d to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11d. A person may be denied bail pending trial if a
- 9 judge or magistrate determines by clear and convincing evidence
- 10 that requiring bail and conditions of release is insufficient to
- 11 reasonably ensure:
- 12 (1) the person's appearance in court as required; or
- (2) the safety of the community or of any person,
- 14 including the victim of the alleged offense.
- 15 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 16 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 17 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the denial
- 19 of bail to an accused person if necessary to ensure the person's
- 20 appearance in court and the safety of the community and of any
- 21 person, including the victim of the alleged offense."
