## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation of
- 2 the water infrastructure resiliency fund and the critical
- 3 infrastructure resiliency fund to assist in the financing of
- 4 certain infrastructure projects.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 49-d-15 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 49-d-15. (a) The water infrastructure resiliency fund
- 9 is created as a special fund in the state treasury outside the
- 10 general revenue fund.
- 11 <u>(b) As provided by general law</u>, money in the water
- 12 infrastructure resiliency fund may be administered and used,
- 13 without further appropriation, by the Texas Water Development Board
- 14 or that board's successor in function to provide financing for
- 15 weatherizing and hardening water and wastewater systems
- (c) Separate accounts may be established in the water
- 17 infrastructure resiliency fund as necessary to administer the fund
- 18 or authorized projects.
- 19 SECTION 2. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 20 adding Section 49-q to read as follows:
- Sec. 49-q. (a) The critical infrastructure resiliency fund
- 22 <u>is created as a special fund in the state treasury outside the</u>
- 23 general revenue fund.
- 24 (b) As provided by general law, money in the critical

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- 1 infrastructure resiliency fund may be administered and used,
- 2 without further appropriation, by the Texas Division of Emergency
- 3 Management or that division's successor in function to provide
- 4 financing for:
- 5 (1) localized improvements to the electric grid;
- 6 (2) improvements at and between buildings to create
- 7 micro-grids;
- 8 (2) hardening lines of emergency communication; and
- 9 (3) purchasing reserve power supply such as onsite
- 10 generation and energy storage systems necessary to sustain:
- 11 (A) emergency communications; and
- 12 <u>(B) critical medical care.</u>
- 13 (c) Separate accounts may be established in the critical
- 14 infrastructure resiliency fund as necessary to administer the fund
- 15 or authorized projects.
- 16 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 20 creation of the modern infrastructure fund to assist in the
- 21 financing of modern electric, transportation, and communications
- 22 infrastructure projects."
