A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature
- 2 to review and terminate an order issued by the governor during a
- 3 state of disaster or emergency declared by the governor.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 42 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42. (a) Notwithstanding Section 40 of this article,
- 8 the legislature may review and terminate during a regular or
- 9 special session an order issued by the governor during a state of
- 10 <u>disaster or emergency declared by the governor. The legislature may</u>
- 11 terminate the order by passage of a resolution approved by a
- 12 majority vote of the members present in each house of the
- 13 <u>legislature</u>.
- 14 (b) A vote under Subsection (a) of this section is not
- 15 subject to Section 15, Article IV, of this constitution.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
- 20 legislature to review and terminate an order issued by the governor
- 21 during a state of disaster or emergency declared by the governor."
