A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment regarding certain
- 2 organizational and procedural matters related to the legislature.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 3, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 3. The Senators shall be chosen by the qualified voters
- 7 for the term of four years; but a new Senate shall be chosen after
- 8 every apportionment, and the Senators elected after each
- 9 apportionment shall be divided by lot into two classes. The seats of
- 10 the Senators of the first class shall be vacated at the expiration
- 11 of the first two years, and those of the second class at the
- 12 expiration of four years, so that one half of the Senators shall be
- 13 chosen biennially thereafter. Senators shall take office following
- 14 their election, on the day set [by law] for the convening of the
- 15 [Regular Session of the] Legislature for an organizational session
- 16 <u>under Section 5a of this article</u>, and shall serve thereafter for the
- 17 full term of years to which elected.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 4, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 4. The Members of the House of Representatives shall be
- 21 chosen by the qualified voters for the term of two years.
- 22 Representatives shall take office following their election, on the
- 23 day set [by law] for the convening of the [Regular Session of the]
- 24 Legislature for an organizational session under Section 5a of this

- 1 <u>article</u>, and shall serve thereafter for the full term of years to
- 2 which elected.
- 3 SECTION 3. Sections 5(b) and (c), Article III, Texas
- 4 Constitution, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (b) When convened in regular session [Session], the
- 6 legislature may [first thirty days thereof shall be devoted to the
- 7 introduction of bills and resolutions, acting upon emergency
- 8 appropriations, passing upon the confirmation of the recess
- 9 appointees of the Governor and such emergency matters as may be
- 10 submitted by the Governor in special messages to the Legislature.
- 11 During the succeeding thirty days of the regular session of the
- 12 Legislature the various committees of each House shall] hold
- 13 hearings and act on [to consider all] bills and resolutions,
- 14 including appropriations, [and other matters then pending; and such
- 15 emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor. During the
- 16 remainder of the session the Legislature shall act upon such bills
- 17 and resolutions as may be then pending and upon such] emergency
- 18 matters as may be submitted by the Governor in special messages to
- 19 the legislature, and any other matter not otherwise prohibited by
- 20 this constitution or the applicable rules of procedure adopted by
- 21 <u>each house of the legislature</u> [Legislature].
- (c) The speaker of the house of representatives shall
- 23 <u>announce committee assignments not later than the second Tuesday in</u>

- 1 SECTION 4. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 2 adding Section 5a to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 5a. (a) The legislature shall convene for an
- 4 organizational session at noon on the second Tuesday in December of
- 5 each even-numbered year. When convened for an organizational
- 6 session the legislature may take only the following actions:
- 7 (1) swearing in of members;
- 8 (2) election of officers under Section 9 of this
- 9 article; and
- 10 (3) adoption of rules of procedure under Section 11 of
- 11 this article.
- 12 <u>(b) The number of days convened in an organizational session</u>
- 13 under this section does not count toward the maximum duration of a
- 14 regular session under Section 24 of this article.
- 15 SECTION 5. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 16 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 17 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment regarding certain
- 19 organizational and procedural matters related to the legislature."
