A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment regarding certain
- 2 organizational and procedural matters related to the legislature.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 3, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 3. The Senators shall be chosen by the qualified voters
- 7 for the term of four years; but a new Senate shall be chosen after
- 8 every apportionment, and the Senators elected after each
- 9 apportionment shall be divided by lot into two classes. The seats
- 10 of the Senators of the first class shall be vacated at the
- 11 expiration of the first two years, and those of the second class at
- 12 the expiration of four years, so that one half of the Senators shall
- 13 be chosen biennially thereafter. Senators shall take office
- 14 following their election, on the day set [by law] for the convening
- 15 of the [Regular Session of the] Legislature for an organizational
- 16 session under Section 5a of this article, and shall serve
- 17 thereafter for the full term of years to which elected.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 4, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 4. The Members of the House of Representatives shall be
- 21 chosen by the qualified voters for the term of two years.
- 22 Representatives shall take office following their election, on the
- 23 day set [by law] for the convening of the [Regular Session of the]
- 24 Legislature for an organizational session under Section 5a of this

- which elected. 2
- Section 5, Article III, Texas Constitution, is 3 SECTION 3.
- amended to read as follows: 4
- Sec. 5. MEETINGS[+ ORDER OF BUSINESS]. (a) The Legislature 5
- shall meet every two years at such time as may be provided by law and 6
- at other times when convened by the Governor. 7
- 8 When convened in regular Session, the Legislature may
- hold hearings and act upon legislation, appropriations, 9
- resolutions, emergency matters submitted by the Governor in special 10
- messages to the Legislature, and any other matters not otherwise 11
- 12 prohibited by law or relevant rules adopted by each House [first
- thirty days thereof shall be devoted to the introduction of bills 13
- 14 and resolutions, acting upon emergency appropriations, passing
- upon the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor and 15
- such emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in 16
- 17 special messages to the Legislature. During the succeeding thirty
- days of the regular session of the Legislature the various 18
- 19 committees of each House shall hold hearings to consider all bills
- and resolutions and other matters then pending; and such emergency 20
- matters as may be submitted by the Governor. During the remainder 21
- of the session the Legislature shall act upon such bills and
- resolutions as may be then pending and upon such emergency matters 23
- 24 as may be submitted by the Governor in special messages to the

- 26 The speaker of the house of representatives shall
- announce committee assignments not later than the second Tuesday in 27

- 1 January following the convening of the legislature in regular
- 2 <u>session</u> [Notwithstanding Subsection (b), either House may
- 3 determine its order of business by an affirmative vote of
- 4 four-fifths of its membership].
- 5 SECTION 4. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 5a to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 5a. (a) The legislature shall convene for an</u>
- 8 organizational session at noon on the second Tuesday in December of
- 9 each even-numbered year. When convened for an organizational
- 10 session the legislature may take only the following actions:
- 11 (1) swearing in of members;
- 12 (2) election of officers under Section 9 of this
- 13 article; and
- 14 (3) adoption of rules of procedure under Section 11 of
- 15 <u>this article.</u>
- 16 (b) The number of days convened in an organizational session
- 17 under this section does not count toward the maximum duration of a
- 18 regular session under Section 24 of this article.
- 19 SECTION 5. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment regarding certain
- 23 organizational and procedural matters related to the legislature."
