## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article II, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 2 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2. (a) The legislature by general law may provide for
- 9 legislative review or approval of a rule that is adopted by an
- 10 agency in the executive department:
- 11 (1) without prior notice or hearing, or after an
- 12 <u>abbreviated period for notice and hearing; and</u>
- 13 (2) in response to a threat of imminent peril to public
- 14 health, safety, or welfare.
- 15 (b) A general law enacted under this section may:
- 16 (1) prescribe procedures regarding the renewal of a
- 17 rule by a state agency; and
- (2) delegate powers to either legislative house,
- 19 including committees in those houses.
- 20 <u>(c) A general law enacted under this section may not</u>
- 21 authorize a person who is not an elected member of the legislature
- 22 to participate in the review or approval of rules adopted by
- 23 agencies in the executive department.
- 24 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

- 1 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 2 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 3 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 4 legislature to provide for legislative review or approval of
- 5 certain state agency rules adopted in response to a threat to public
- 6 health, safety, or welfare."
